### A note of appreciation.

Thanks for everyone's patience during the paving improvements to the Fox River Trail. Ultimately, a safer path is worth the small inconvenience.

### Continue to Recycle

The recycling barrels in the parks are being put to good use. We have doubled the size of the container used to transport all of the collected items to the recycling center.

### Emerald Ash Borer

We have observed Emerald Ash Borer in a few of our sites.

At locations with small caliper trees, we have already planted potential replacements in proximity to the ash. Locations with larger and smaller caliper trees are being systematically treated with an injection process.

As always, please remember that our outdoor restrooms are closed in mid-October and will not re-open until mid-April, 2011.
