- 1'-6" T Box, 14' wide
- 4' Quarter Bank, 18' wide
- 1' Straight Grind Rail, 12' long
- 5' Mini Ramp, 24' wide
- 6' Roll-In, 5' Trani-Bank
- 4' Hipped Bank, 24' wide
- 2' Half Pyramid, 12' wide
- 3'- 6" Launch Box, 8' wide
- 6'- 5' Slope Slide, 30' wide

Skate Park Warnings & Safety Rules

- The skate/bicycle park is unsupervised and participants skate/ bike at their own risk.
- The skate park is open March 1-November 30 weather permitting.
- It is REQUIRED that proper protective equipment such as helmets, elbow pads, knee pads, etc. be used during skating and cycling activities.
- CAUTION: Bicycling, inline skating and skateboarding are high risk recreational activities with inherent risk of serious injury.
- No personally owned ramps, boxes or other devices may be brought into the facility.
- No motorized equipment may be brought into the facility.
- Please be courteous of other park users.
- Bringing glass into the area is prohibited.
- Please keep your skate park clean.
- In the event rules are not being followed, the Geneva Park District may choose, at its own discretion, to temporarily or permanently close this facility.
