



Dear Camp Wolf Parent:

We are happy to have your child enrolled in Camp Wolf! Our goal is provide a fun, safe environment for exploring the natural world.

Your child will need to bring a sack lunch each day. A small snack will be provided. Please make sure your child brings a water bottle to camp. Most of the day will be spent outdoors. Campers tend to get hot and dirty, so please dress your child for outdoor exploration - **no open toed shoes please**. We recommend that you apply insect repellent and sunscreen before your child arrives at camp. In case of inclement weather (or really HOT days) children will spend some time inside the air-conditioned Orientation Barn or Peck House.

You may use the circular driveway to drop off and pick up your child. You will also be required to sign your child in and out of each camp session with the counselor(s). If someone other than a parent is picking your child up, we need a written note with the name(s) of the person(s) picking up your child.

Please fill out the medical form and bring it with you on the first day of camp. We are looking forward to getting to know your child and exploring Peck Farm Interpretive Center!
