

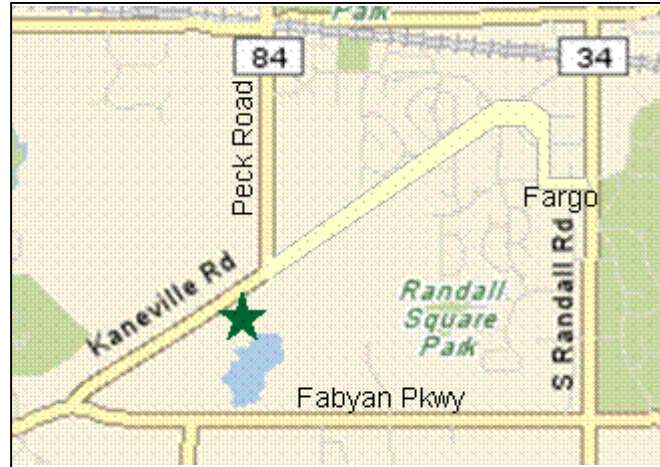
Planning Guide

Length of time for the following activities:

In order by grade level**

Rewarding

Insect Ecology - Grades Pre-K - 3.



Learn to classify insects based on their body parts. Explore Peck Prairie searching for and collecting

bugs and insects. Study the life cycles of various insects living in the prairie. Experience the beauty of the Butterfly House (Memorial Day through September).

Educational

Wildlife Ecology - Grades Pre-k and up.

What wild animals live in your backyard, park, or school? Learn about habitats, adaptations, food chains, and wildlife in this fun, hands-on educational program. This is an excellent winter program.

Prairie Biodiversity - Grades 3 and up.

Explore the diverse prairie while learning about various plants and animals. Learn about their adaptations and why they are so unique. Discover the biodiversity of the prairie by conducting science experiments.

Enlightening

Orienteering - Grades 5 and up.

Orienteering is a great way to put your math skills to the test. Make huge geometrical shapes by using your compass and pacing the correct number of steps to create your shapes. Once mastered, you'll be going on a scavenger hunt using your newly learned skills to trek your way through the prairie trails.



General Information

Cost for Geneva schools starts at \$2 per student. Out-of-district schools starts at \$3 per student. There is a minimum charge of \$25 per group. Program length 1½ hours minimum. Half day and full day programs are available for an additional cost.



We can accommodate up to 4 classes at one time (approximately 25 students per class). Additional time will be needed for 3 or more classes. There is a picnic shelter available to use for lunch at no extra charge.
