## Dance Attire Requirements

### Tiny Toes/Pre-Ballet/Ballet/Lyrical

Students study the beautiful art of ballet in a fun, yet professional environment. Through movement and terminology, students learn grace, improve coordination and flexibility and develop confidence. Tiny Toes and Pre-Ballet classes introduce simple ballet movements and terminology through fun music, cute choreography, and props. Lyrical ballet is the fusion of ballet and jazz and allows the dancer to express emotion through the movements. To progress onto Ballet II, III, or IV instructor approval is required for enrollment. Detailed class sheets are available outside of the dance room.

**Required dance attire includes:**

- Leotard
- Pink or tan tights
- Pink leather ballet shoes - *cut laces off*
- Hair pulled away from face (in bun or braid)
- Ballet skirts may be worn
- No baggy or street clothes

*Note: Label all shoes with name & home phone number.*

### Tap

Make some noise and develop coordination, rhythm, and timing. Participants learn technique with barre, and center work combinations and routines. To progress onto Tap II instructor approval is required for enrollment. Detailed class sheets are available outside of the dance room.

**Required dance attire includes:**

- Leotard
- Pink, tan, or black tights
- Tap shoes
- Tight fitting jazz pants may be worn
- Hair pulled away from face (in bun or braid)
- No baggy or street clothes

*Note: Label all shoes with name & home phone number.*

### Jazz/Hip Hop

Jazz dance introduces participants to new rhythms, steps, and movements in a fun and exciting atmosphere that will increase flexibility and strength. Hip Hop dancing emulates the dance steps seen in music videos or on dance teams. Bring lots of energy! To progress onto Jazz II, III, or IV and Hip Hop II and III, instructor approval is required for enrollment. Detailed class sheets are available outside of the dance room.

**Required dance attire includes:**

- Leotard
- Pink, tan, or black tights
- Hair pulled away from face (in bun or braid)
- Tight fitting jazz pants or
- No baggy or street clothes
- Jazz class: jazz shoes (*no gym shoes*)
- Hip Hop class: jazz shoes (*no gym shoes*)

*Note: Label all shoes with name & home number.*

### Irish Step Dance

Irish dance has become the hottest craze to learn. To progress onto Level II instructor approval required for enrollment. Irish step shoes may be purchased from instructor.

**Required dance attire includes:**

- Dance top and pants
- Jazz or ballet leather shoes
- Hair pulled away from face
